### SNAPSHOT #2 I FEEL PRETTY

#### *Shulamith*

- 5 I am dark, but lovely,  
O daughters of Jerusalem,
- 6 Do not stare at me,  
Because I am dark,  
Because the sun has scorched me.  
My mother's sons were angry with me;  
They made me the keeper of the vineyards,  
But I have not taken care of my own vineyard.
- 7 Tell me, O you whom my soul loves,  
Where do you pasture your flock,  
Where you make it rest at noon?  
For why should I be as one who veils herself  
By the flocks of your companions.

#### *Daughters of Jerusalem*

- 8 If you do not know,  
O most beautiful among women,  
Go forth on the trail of the flock,  
And pasture your young goats  
Beside the tents of the shepherds.
