Luke 6:38 "Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

Luke 16:9 "Make friends for yourselves by unrighteous mammon [money], that when you fail, they may receive you into an everlasting home."

Luke 16:11 "If you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon [mammon], who will commit to your trust the true riches?" [Luke 12:33]

Luke 21:1 He looked up and saw the rich putting their gifts into the treasury, 2 and He saw also a certain poor widow putting in two mites. 3 So He said, "Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all; 4 "for all these out of their abundance have put in offerings for God, but she out of her poverty put in all the livelihood that she had."
