## Is That in the Bible? All Things Work Together for Good

Romans 8:28 We know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.  
29 ...to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

John 14:23 "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word... 24 He who does not love Me does not keep my words."

Luke 8:21 "My brothers are these who hear the word of God and do it." [John 1:12; 15:14]

Deuteronomy 21:17 "He shall acknowledge...the firstborn by giving him a double portion of all that he has."

Romans 8:17 If children, then heirs -- heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together. 18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
