Creation: 24?

Genesis 5:3 And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a *son* in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth... 6 Seth lived one hundred and five years, and begot Enosh... 11:26 Terah lived seventy years, and begot Abram.

Luke 3:23 Now Jesus Himself began *His ministry at* about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) *the son of Joseph...* 37 *the son of Methuselah, the son of Enoch, the son of Jared, the son of Mahalalel, the son of Cainan,* 38 *the son of Enosh, the son of Seth, the son of Adam, the son of God.*

Jude 1:14 Enoch, the seventh from Adam.

Mark 10:6 From the beginning of the creation, God 'made them male and female.'

Matthew 19:4 He answered and said to them, "Have you not read that He who made them at the beginning 'made them male and female,'"

Exodus 20: 11 In six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.

Genesis 1: 5 God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day.

8 So the evening and the morning were the second day. 13 So the evening and the morning were the third day. 19 So the evening and the morning were the fourth day. 23 So the evening and the morning were the fifth day. 31 So the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

Genesis 1:14 Then God said, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years. " 16 Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. *He made* the stars also.

Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. 2 He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created.

II Peter 3:8 With the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

1. Can you tell about a time that you believed in atheistic or theistic evolution? Why did you believe that way?

2. How does it make you feel to know that there are thousands of scientists who believe in six-day creation?

3. Think about the difference it makes to believe in theistic evolution (God did it in millions of years) or to believe in six-day creation (God did it in six 24-hour days). For example, if six-day creation is true, what does that tell you about God? What does that tell you about the Bible?

4. If six-day creation is true, what does that tell you about God's involvement with needs in your life and in the lives of your loved ones? Please explain.
